

Hearts Like Ours

Count: 32 Wall: 4 Level: **Improver**
Choreographer: Justine Brown & Lorna Dennis (Aug 2014)
Music: Ring of Fire - Paul Bailey

MODIFIED RUMBA BOX, COASTER STEP

- 1 - 2 Step Right to right side. Step Left beside right.
- 3 - 4 Step Forward on Right. Step Left to Left side.
- 5 - 6 Step Right beside left. Step Back on Left.
- 7&8 Step Back on Right. Step left beside right. Step forward on Right.

WALK FORWARD X4 (OR FULL TURN), KICK, STEP BACK, SHUFFLE BACK.

(DIP KNEES AS YOU START THE WALKS)

- 1 - 2 Step Forward on Left. Step Forward on Right.
- 3 - 4 Step Forward on Left. Step Forward on Right.
- *1-4 **Optional full turn forward – Step fwd L, Full turn over left stepping (R) (L), Step fwd (R)***
- 5 – 6 Kick Left Forward. Step Back on Left
- 7 & 8 Step Back on Right. Small step Left beside Right. Step Back on Right.

BACK ROCK, RECOVER, $\frac{3}{4}$ HINGE TURN, CROSS ROCK, SIDE SHUFFLE.

- 1 - 2 Rock Back onto Left. Recover forward onto Right.
- 3 - 4 Turn $\frac{1}{4}$ over right stepping forward on Left. Turn $\frac{1}{2}$ right stepping right to the side. (9:00)
- 5 - 6 Cross Rock Left over right. Recover back onto right.
- 7 & 8 Step Left to left side. Small step Right beside left. Step Left to left side.

WEAVE LEFT, $\frac{1}{4}$ TURN, STEP PIVOT $\frac{3}{4}$, SIDE, SLIDE.

- 1 - 2 Cross Right over left. Step Left to left side.
- 3 - 4 Cross Right behind left. Turn $\frac{1}{4}$ left stepping Left forward. (6:00)
- 5 - 6 Step Forward on Right. Pivot $\frac{3}{4}$ Left. (9:00)
- 7 - 8 Big Step Right to right side. Slide Left beside right.

(Spread arms to the side as you slide, Fly like a bird style)

Ending: On the final wall you will end the dance at count 30 instead of doing a $\frac{3}{4}$ turn make it a half turn to the front and add a little run forward (7&8 R-L-R) and pose! Of course J
